- experience in helping to developing GIS solutions under an Azure Cloud umbrella
- Experience in creating, publishing, and managing map services
- Previous experience working with the libraries: GDAL, DotSpatial, OpenLayers and / or Leaflet
- Knowledge of Microsoft Technologies in .NET and Web Apps (jQuery, AngularJS, ExtJS or similar)
- Experience working with GIS data sources such as PostGIS, SQL Spatial or similar
- Current understanding of best practices regarding system security measures
- Understanding of design patterns and application levels
- Understanding of accessibility standards.
- Cross-browser coding skills
- Able to easily pick up and follow required design guidelines for a development project. These may differ between applications and product releases.
- Be aware of common industry standards and coding best-practices within your disciplines and apply them as required.
